



## Congratulations to Tui

**T**ui Selvaratnam, AGA tournament operations manager, posted her best-ever finish in a USGA event, reaching the semifinals of the U.S. Women's Mid-Amateur held at Holston Hills C.C. in Knoxville, Tenn.

Selvaratnam came up short in the semifinals, losing to the eventual champion Corey Weworski of Carlsbad, Calif. She finished the 36-hole stroke play qualifying tied for eighth place at 151. Selvaratnam, a former ASU standout and three-time NCAA champion, went on to win her first two matches 8&7 and 9&8, the latter tying a record for largest margin of victory in the Championship. She reached the quarters with a 4&2 victory over Carol Semple Thompson.



"The experience was unbelievable and will be something I will never forget," Selvaratnam said. "The biggest thing was getting past the second round, and after that I was just floating. I just kept on winning, and it would have been one more match if I had won the semifinals – but that's golf."

card? Those days are over. The AGA's Arizona Handicap Network has created a way for golfers to receive their USGA handicap information via email. Called E-Revision, the AGA member benefit is easy and convenient – anywhere you can access your email, you can access your current handicap information. In addition, if your club allows Internet posting, the process has gotten easier. Now choosing your club and logging in with your email address and password will take you directly to the score posting pages.

Both member benefits are quick to use, easy to get and available right now. Just go to [azgolf.org](http://azgolf.org) to register your email and password. Click on "FIRST TIME LOGIN." To register, you will need to enter your AGA member number. PLEASE NOTE: This is not your local number. Once the system recognizes you, enter your email address and password. You will be able to begin posting scores immediately and you will automatically receive your E-Revision on the next

revision date (the 1st and the 15th of each month).

Your email address will be the sole property of the AGA and will not be shared. Sign up for E-Revision and Internet posting today.
