

ARIZONA NATIONAL WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

STANDING RULES

1. Membership shall be open to female golfers who maintain a handicap issued by the Arizona Golf Association (AGA) through Arizona National Golf Club and whose application has been approved by the AZNWGA Board. Prospective members will be invited to play a round of golf with current AZNWGA members, preferably on a Thursday play day. Following the round of golf and the submission of a completed application, the Board will make a final determination. An email will be sent to the prospective member to thank them for playing golf at our club and notifying them of the board's decision.
2. Membership in AZNWGA does not qualify a person for participation in Arizona National Golf Club sponsored events such as Club Championship, Member/Member or Member/Guest.
3. Play Day shall be Thursdays. Two (2) or three (3) day tournaments may be scheduled on alternative days.
4. Dues shall be \$30.00 per year payable no later December 1 or the first time a member plays thereafter, whichever occurs first. New members who join and paid dues between on October 1 and December 31 shall not pay annual dues for the upcoming year.
5. Members must keep a current GHIN handicap with Arizona National Golf Club. Anyone joining the AZNWGA from another club must pay her GHIN handicap fees through Arizona National Golf Club as well.
6. A member may compete in the "Game of the Day" after establishing a GHIN Handicap. Participation in "Game of the Day" is optional. All play shall be governed by USGA rules or as modified by local course rules. Participants in "Game of the Day" or major events shall play to a maximum course handicap of 40. AZNWGA will support "Game of the Day". During "Game of the Day", the equal stroke control (posting max) will be used to allow participants to continue in the play if the hole in question is not part of the game.
7. A payout of \$50 is made to the player per Hole-in-One on the day of League Play. An additional \$50 can be allocated to cover cost of beverages for AZNWGA members playing on the play day of the Hole-in-One.
8. During league play; for speed of play, a provisional ball may be played before going to look for the first ball. If first ball is playable, no need for provisional ball. If the first ball is unplayable, no need to go back and re-tee, but can use the provisional ball.
9. Guests of AZNWGA members may play on play day, but may not compete for prize money. A guest is limited to three (3) times per year.
10. AZNWGA members who wish to participate in sanctioned events such as Ironwood Cup, Kachina, Southern District, etc. are ENCOURAGED to play with AZNWGA on play days once a month or at least 5 times per year.
