

Here are the answers to questions frequently asked about the Palo Verde Ladies Golf Association (PVLGA)

PV Ladies Lounge

- Located inside to the left in the Women's Restroom at the PV Clubhouse.
- Contains bulletin boards used to post information important to all PVLGA members including special events, holes in one, ringers, etc.
- Contains a locked drawer with a slot where checks for special events can be deposited.

PVLGA DUES

- Dues are \$80 and are payable no later than December 1.
- Dues are paid on line. Detailed how-to information will be provided when the annual dues are to be paid.
- Dues are allocated to the Arizona Women's Golf Association to maintain our handicaps, payouts (in the form of chits) for Tuesday play, and to cover miscellaneous expenses such as office supplies, awards, etc.
- A late fee is charged if dues are renewed after December 1.

Chelsea System

- Used to request tee times for Tuesday Ladies Day games and non-league play.
- The Chelsea System is available through your computer, cell phone or tablet.
- Annual golf membership will be given priority in Chelsea for tee times.
- If you have a punch card, you will not be given tee time priority.
- You will receive an e-mail a couple of days before your requested play date advising you of your tee time, the hole you will be starting on and the names of the people you will play with.
- The Pros can assist you if you do not know how to log into Chelsea.

Recording Scores

- You can post your scores online at WWW.AZGOLF.ORG from home or on the computer in the Pro Shop. You may also use the GHIN app.
- You will need the AWGA GHIN number that was given to you when you paid your dues.
- The posting of scores is monitored to assure that our handicaps reflect all our scores.
- REMEMBER, ALL GAMES MUST BE POSTED, REGARDLESS OF WHAT COURSE YOU HAVE PLAYED!

Special Events/Tournaments

- A sign-up sheet will be posted in the Ladies Lounge for special events such as the Cotton/Verde, Member/Guest and PICO Crossover.
- DO NOT sign up on Chelsea for special events. See the Calendar on this website.
- Sign-up sheets are put up one month prior to the event and taken down no later than the prior Friday at noon.
- Some of these events will require an entry fee. In those cases, you must pay the fee when you sign up. PAYMENT IS BY CHECK ONLY- DO NOT PAY IN CASH.
- Make checks payable to PVLGA and reference the name of the event on the memo line.
- Put your check in the slot in the locked drawer in the PV Ladies Locker Room.
- Checks written in pencil will not be accepted.
- The President's Cup and Club Championship events DO NOT require an entry fee.
 - You need only to sign up and the Handicap Chair will check all names for eligibility.

Regular Tuesday Ladies Day

- As per above, you will sign up through Chelsea.
- You can sign up 7 days in advance.
- CANCELLATIONS MUST BE MADE WITH THE PRO SHOP before noon on the Monday prior to the shotgun start.
- The designated Captain of each foursome will keep the official score, settle disputes and assist new members with the rules.
- The Pro Shop will post postable scores for Tuesday Ladies Day play.

Luncheon/Business Meetings

- These meetings are held on a Tuesday Ladies Day in January, March, May, October, and December.
- The sign-up sheet will be posted on the bulletin board in the Ladies Lounge.
- **NOTE: these are a 'package' deal – you must pay for the luncheon that day if you want to play.**

Additional Opportunities (All Optional):

The Hole-In-One Club

- Costs \$5.00 to join and ensures that if you get a Hole-In-One during Tuesday Ladies Day the club will provide you with \$100.00.
- It is recommended that you buy drinks for only the foursome you played with.
- Once the fund has been depleted, you will need to reactivate your membership by paying another \$5.00.
- The treasurer will advise the board when funds are low.

Ringers Club

- \$5 per year.
- Flighted according to handicap.
- Your best Tuesday Ladies Day score for the period on each hole will be recorded for you.
- Winners will receive cash prizes at the end of the Ringers period.

CAGD (Central Arizona Golf District)

- \$8 per year.
- There are five blind draws per year that are held on regular Tuesday Ladies Day.
- On those days, you will need to pay an additional \$1.00 and turn in an individual score card to the Pro Shop.
- **NOTE: Contact the CAGD Chairwoman for further information and payment instructions.**

Keeping Informed

- A calendar of the year's special events and regular weekly games is available in the Pro Shop and on the PVLGA website.
- The bulletin board in the Ladies Lounge displays upcoming events flyers, sign-up sheets, the Hole-In-One Club list, the Ringers Club List, CAGD information, AWGA information, etc.
- Visit our website at www.pvlga.com frequently.
- A password is needed to open the member directory section of the website so that our personal information is not accessible to non-members.
- The password will be provided to you by a Board Member.
- If you have questions about this information, reach out to a Board Member.
- A list of Board Members is posted in locker room and on the PVLGA website.
