Valley Team – The PWGA team won the combined trophy for the most gross and net points. Yay! The Wigwam WGA won the most net points and the Arizona Country Club WGA won the most gross points. North Valley Team – The PWGA team did OK this year but did not place. Lauren will continue to coordinate this event. It is open to any players that have a 30 handicap and under. It is match play and let Lauren know if you would like to play.

State Medallion – Congratulations to Karen Pultz, gross winner and Maria Cockrum, net winner. Karen and Maria will represent the PWGA in the State Medallion Tournament in January 2019.

2018/19 Season

Dues – The amount of the dues will not change for the 2018/19 season. If payment is received before 8/1/2018 the dues will be \$75.00. If after 8/1/2018, the dues will be \$80. The AWGA is raising its membership fees by \$5.00 for individuals joining after January 1st. The PWGA dues will be the same the entire year. Note that the PWGA had 80 regular members this season and 74 last season.

Food – The clubhouse construction is expected to be completed by next season and open for business. We will be using the clubhouse restaurant to cater our luncheons when we have them and include the cost of the food in the greens fees. Betsy Owen will work with the Dining Room manager for the luncheon.

PODs – Doris and Maria will be working on the POD schedule through the first half of June. Input is welcome

CTPs – Next season there will be separate CTPs for the low and high handicappers. On a trial basis, to see how this works out, CTPs will be \$3.00 for each of the two flights for a total of \$6.00 instead of \$5.00 for one winner per hole. We will also be purchasing tape measures to use for the CTPs instead of the sticks.

Major Tournaments – There will be no major changes to the major tournaments next season. We still need to decide on the entry fees and how to incorporate the food expenses into the fees. We would like to see more participation from our members in the major tournaments; in particular the Wild Safari, President's Cup and the Club Championship. A suggestion was to combine the President's Cup and Club Championship and have gross and net winners. Also there may be a gold tee flight.

Tee Choices – We will continue to have the same options for tee choices

USGA Rules – The USGA will be implementing some new rules in January 2019. Please watch your handicap revision emails for information on the new rules. Also, the AWGA and AGA will be holding seminars on the new rules.
